<u>Section 3</u>: The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Auditor of Trumbull County for the calculation by that County Auditor of the total current tax valuation of the District and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by 4.3 mills as provided in O.R.C. §5705.03.

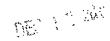
