**Is the McDonald Local School District still committed to building an athletic complex on the corner of McDonald Ave. and 2<sup>nd</sup> St?**

The Board of Education is still actively working with the GPD Group to build an athletic complex on 2<sup>nd</sup> St. and McDonald Ave.

**What time frame does the district have for the athletic complex?**

The Board is currently working on the bids for Phase One of the project. This work is tentatively scheduled to begin in the spring of 2020.

- **Update- Phase One bids were received at the McDonald Board of Education Office on Thursday March 19, 2020. The Board will consider the bid at the next meeting, which has not been scheduled at this time.**

**What issues have caused the delay in the start of the project?**

After the completion of environmental and wetland studies and a complex negotiation with the sellers, the Board of Education was finally able to purchase the land in November of 2018. Since that date we have been working with the GPD Group to establish the scope and sequence of the construction phase moving forward.

**Does the Board of Education have a completion Date for the athletic complex?**

At the current time Phase One is tentatively scheduled to begin in the spring of 2020. We will be working with the GPD Group to establish additional time-lines in the near future.
